Making a Difference one Child at a Time



AdventureImpact is all about getting alongside—being a helping hand

Almost every day in the media there are such sad reports about the welfare of our children and young people. One government funded study announced that one in four girls have depression by the time they hit 14!

According to the Department for Education, the number of children excluded from full time education is expected to be over 167,000 in England by July and according to the charity Home for Good, the UK needs more than 9,000 additional foster families. Now, more than ever, these children need consistency in care and support and to find places where they can feel safe and loved; then they can start to flourish and believe in a brighter future.

At Adventure Impact we are working hard to do just that! We were delighted to be able to welcome six children referred from social services or 'link workers' places at our Total Adventure Holiday this summer. Each child comes with their own worries and feelings of low self-esteem, which often becomes evident in the way they approach activities or interact with others. It was great to see them begin to relax as the week progressed enjoying themselves and having fun with friends and leaders. The feedback by the end of the week was really positive. One of the children in 'Kinship Care' told his granny it was the best thing he'd done all summer and wished it was longer than just a week!

We'll look forward to seeing him back on an Activity Day soon and then for another week with us next year.

We were also able to provide places for four Syrian refugee children, based locally and supported by the volunteers at Asylum Welcome. The children thoroughly enjoyed being outdoors, having fun and making new friends; we were even treated to a Syrian song, sung by two of the boys at 'TA's Got Talent'. The families see A+ as a 'safe place' for their children and they too are looking forward to coming back next year.

That was the summer, so what now? Our team is growing and we are planning to provide more opportunities to work alongside children with additional needs whether on regular activity days, at weekends, or school holidays. During term time we plan to offer programmes to support children excluded from school, providing mentoring programmes and recognised qualifications - alongside a range of outdoor adventures of course!

We believe all these children need to know they are highly valued and greatly loved and that they too deserve a great future supported by a team who consistently care, support and encourage them.

AdventureI*mpact* is looking forward to a very exciting year ahead!

Those who Hope in the Lord will inherit the land...Psalm 37

As we read this psalm during our daily Team Meeting recently it resonated with me for our current mission to buy Windmill Farm and get the Adventure *Base* built.

We've been working to bring this about for 7 years... or 27 if you count the years of preparation - 'learning the ropes' of running an adventure company!

From such unlikely beginnings, a 2-bed flat in Central London with 'no previous experience' and very little to go on but a disturbingly clear, totally un-looked for 'calling' (you can read that part of the story in 'Life to the Max') we really were forced to 'hope in the Lord' – there wasn't much else to place our trust in.

The psalm then declares that 'the humble will possess the land' and it has been a truly humbling experience to see His amazing provision over the past three years, so that on 16th October 2016 the final payment was made, in full and on time, for the purchase of the freehold of Windmill Farm. Wow!

It is particularly refreshing that, although our original 'Feasibility Study' showed that the required funds were out there... 'if all conceivable sources come good in the tight timescale', He chose to provide in a very different way (echoes here of v23: 'The LORD guides us in the way we should go')... which has been both refreshing and very humbling:-

Refreshing because there is no room for the smug satisfaction that our great plan worked. In fact, much of what we'd anticipated did not materialise. For example very little came in during year one from the Charitable Trusts we (thought we) were counting on.

Humbling because that first year saw so many good friends, new and old, giving sacrificially to make this vision a reality, although there was no guarantee we would be able to go on to complete the purchase in years 2 & 3.

Encouragements, as the journey has unfolded, have been huge and far too many to mention: the couple from a local

church who wrote to say that they had both decided to become friends of the Adventure Base (which meant a donation of £1,000 or £50 pcm for five years); when I opened the envelope their meaning became clear as 2 cheques of £1,000 fell out, one from each of them!; or the trauma consultant and mother of a young family who has been working locum shifts in addition to her existing work load, to help ensure we did not miss the deadline; or the couple who signed up for the regular monthly giving - and then sent a £1,000 'friends' single donation too; or the former A+ instructor, newly married, who committed to a gift of £1000 but was not sure how he'd make it happen - so he went out and ran a marathon; or the couple who pledged an amount right at the start of year one, then doubled it as the first deadline approached and promised to do the same at the start of year two to 'keep up the momentum'!

Of course we cannot mention all the many wonderful stories of humbling generosity, but we do want to say a huge

'thank you'

as a team, for *your* part in getting us here, and for so many encouragements along the way, as we have been praying daily through this unfolding 'Adventure of Faith'!

And we have not been idle since we completed the purchase. In addition to welcoming over 7,000 children through A+ in the last year, and growing the ministry of Windmill Farm, we have been working with architects to shape



plans for a phased development of the Adventure *Base...* which, when complete, will enable A+ to double the number of children and youth we reach each year.

It is an awe-inspiring thought that He already knows the children who will be coming through the Adventure *Base*. He sees the smiles and hears their laughter – now that really is a humbling thought which motivates us even more to press on towards the goal...

What next?

Stage 1: **Yurt Village** (winterised with under floor heating!) for 40, with all the services prepositioned for the Adventure *Base*, including **power**, **comms**, 'water in & water out'.

Ablutions block and self-catering **kitchens**, and whilst we're about it we'll also put in 'washrooms' for the **Windmill Farm camping field**.

So if you're looking for the right venue for your church weekend away, we'll have everything from camping with 'all mod cons' to a yurt village for your youth, and 'comfortable residential' twin en suite for those that need it!

Are we excited? Just a bit! But we're also going to need your help to make this happen.

Even as many were so generous in helping us purchase the land, so we pray on that others will take up the baton at this exciting stage.

And all so we can welcome even more children and youth into their own 'adventures, in faith', that we call Life to the Max...


