Each Sunday when there is no family service Crèche meets. From babes in arms to 4 year olds we meet together during the service for our own time of fellowship.

The children (age 4 upwards) meet each Sunday morning during the main service. After joining all together for the first part of the church service, the children can go to their special groups.

We aim to have lots of fun and learn about God. Hope to see you there.

(The children's groups do not meet on the 1st Sunday in the month when it is a Family Service and we all worship together).



Little Fishes



The group is run in the Laurence Hall, Church Road, Cholsey, each Tuesday morning during term time between 9am and 12 midday.

Little Fishes is a great chance for parents. grandparents and carers to meet and chat. We provide a safe and friendly environment in which children can play and be stimulated and strong friendships of all ages are built over cups of coffee or at the craft table. We offer a snack for children around mid morning. We are visited by the Health Visitor on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month. We are a church run group and for those who wish, there is always the chance for prayer, time to talk and information about baptism, weddings or church services. From bumps to pre-schoolers, new mums to experienced hands you can be assured of a warm welcome each time you come.



On the 2nd Sunday of each month (apart from July, August and December), we have a special time in **Moulsford Church** from **4.30 - 5.30pm** for young families.

We start off with cake and soft drinks (or tea for the adults) and a creative activity for the children.

We then have a short (20 minutes) service, with songs, interactive reading of a Bible story, and a child-friendly talk. All young families (with children upto about 10) from Cholsey and Moulsford are welcome.
